**TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT (all caps)**

**Author String**

Author string must include first initial, last name and institution. Omit degrees and titles.

**Body of the Abstract *must include the following components:***

Use 10 point type, preferably Arial or a similar sans-serif font. Use italics for the name of microorganisms. All abstracts must be typed in English. Abstract, including tables/graphs, should **not exceed 1 page (8 ½ x 11) with 1 inch margins single spaced.**

*Purpose/Background:*

A sentence stating the study's purpose, unless stated in the title

*Methods:*

A brief description of the methods

*Results:*

A summary of the results

*Conclusion:*

A statement of conclusions reached. Do not simply state "The results will be discussed."

*Supporting Graphs/Figures*

**Disclosure (Required)**

Enter any research support or financial interest. If you do not have research support or financial interest, simply enter, "Nothing to disclose."

**Trainee Travel Awards**
